Residents were having their blood pressure taken in the dining room. Lunch is served around 12:15, but many residents were in the dining room at 11:30. No beverages were available. The menu displayed on a tv does not match the menu posted outside the dining rooms. Only one choice was available. Ms. Fore stated that there are two sandwich alternatives at lunch and dinner. Dinner may also have leftovers from lunch as a choice.

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Concerns for staffing, especially in the memory care unit. There were 24 residents and only one staff member. The unit is being renovated and not very appealing.

We spoke to two family members who were very concerned about staffing. One family member stated that no breakfast was available one day that week due to the cook not coming in. Another family member mentioned a resident may have been overmedicated. The family member was meeting with administration to discuss medication.

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
