Minutes from the RPO TAC March 27, 2014 Meeting

Brownie Newman motioned to approve Agenda and Minutes, David Brown seconded, and the motion carried.

BUSINESS

Prioritization Draft Ranked list

City of Brevard does not wish to provide the local match commitment letter for the bike/ped project so the 50 points require distribution. A spreadsheet was provided and discussion followed on particular projects, such as US276 Jonathan Creek Road – 79 points maximum. Vicki Eastland reviewed the 421 surplus of points.

David Brown motioned to approve the draft rank order, Lawrence Ponder seconded, and as none were opposed, the motion carried.

LOSRPO remaining point to assign

Mike Sorrells called for any discussion and Brownie Newman asked about north of I-240 section of the connector project. Vicki Eastland replied that it was Broadway to Weaverville and the B section is from that point on to Flat Creek to Madison County line (to Ivy).

The new Smoky Park bridge is important, said Brownie Newman, especially with the current and projected congestion. Michael Sorrells asked for a motion to approve the list as presented from the LOSRPO TCC.

Daryle Hogsed motioned to approve the list as presented from the LOSRPO TCC for the remaining points to be awarded to FBRMPO projects, Lawrence Ponder seconded, and as all were in favor, the motion carried.
