## **Finding Housing Resources**

- 1) NC Housing Search is a free search-engine and customer phone center for people looking for available rental housing. Visit www.nchousingsearch.org or call 877-428-8844.
- 2) Find HUD housing resources: Go to the HUD (US Dept. of Housing and Urban Development) web site at <a href="www.hud.gov">www.hud.gov</a>. On the far-left hand side of the screen there is a list of topics, click <a href="Renting">Renting</a> and you will access the renting page. There are three major kinds of federally subsidized housing listed on this page:
  - **Privately owned subsidized housing:** Click on <u>search for an apartment</u> and click on North Carolina. Select an area by city, county or zip code to get a list of all the privately owned Section 8 properties in your community. Call the property for additional information.
  - Public Housing and Housing Choice Voucher Program (also known as Section 8 tenant based rental assistance) are operated by local public housing authorities (PHAs) or administering agencies. To view a list of all PHAs in NC go to <a href="www.hud.gov/offices/pih/pha/contacts/states/nc.cfm">www.hud.gov/offices/pih/pha/contacts/states/nc.cfm</a>. Many PHAs have preferences for persons with disabilities. Call your local PHA and inquire if wait lists are open for public housing and Section 8. If wait lists are open, make application for the programs. If wait lists are closed, ask how you can be informed of when wait lists are opened.
- 3) Find Rural Housing resources: Go to the USDA (US Dept. of Agriculture) web site at <a href="https://www.rurdev.usda.gov">www.rurdev.usda.gov</a>. On the left side of the screen click list of apartment complexes then search by state and town. This will bring up the list of USDA developments in each county with additional links to project specific information. Call the property for additional information.
- 4) Find Low-Income Housing Tax Credit (LIHTC) Properties: Go to the NC Housing Finance Agency web site at <a href="www.nchfa.com/Applications/Apt\_Afford\_Locator/AAL\_Search.aspx">www.nchfa.com/Applications/Apt\_Afford\_Locator/AAL\_Search.aspx</a>. The <a href="Affordable Housing Locator">Affordable Housing Locator</a> provides information about LIHTC properties by county. Though not subsidized to the extent of other housing listed above, by regulation LIHTC properties must accept Section 8 vouchers from otherwise qualified households and some LIHTC projects have project based rental assistance making them affordable to persons with extremely-low income. Call the property for additional information.
